I greet you in the most high God! Here is my brief ministry history.

While I was reading in Facebook I got a friend request from Brother Ray Hoggard, and I accepted his request, and informed me of the primitive church.

He sent me the article of faith through emails, and shared to my congregation and agreed to follow it.
